

Precept Study: Worldliness is Sin – The Harlot Church *Part-3*

In Regards to: Unfaithfulness (idolatry), Spiritual fornication (whoredom), carnality and worldliness in the church. **Your Body, His Temple. Part-3**

HEAR YE THE WORD OF THE LORD;

- * ... the land has committed great harlotry *By departing* from the LORD." (Hos 1:2 NKJ)
- * They will not frame their doings to turn unto their God: for the spirit of whoredoms *is* in the midst of them, and they have not known the LORD. (Hos 5:4 KJV)
- * ... for they *be* all adulterers, an assembly of treacherous men. (Jer 9:2 KJV)
- * And they bend their tongues *like* their bow *for* lies: but they are not valiant for the truth upon the earth; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they know not me, saith the LORD. (Jer 9:3 KJV)
- * For both prophet and priest are profane; yea, in my house have I found their wickedness, saith the LORD. (Jer 23:11 KJV)
- * Wherefore their way shall be unto them as slippery *ways* in the darkness: they shall be driven on, and fall therein: for I will bring evil upon them, *even* the year of their visitation, saith the LORD. (Jer 23:12 KJV)
- * ... they prophesied in Baal, and caused my people Israel to err. (Jer 23:13 KJV)
- * I have seen also in the prophets of Jerusalem an horrible thing: they commit adultery, and walk in lies: they strengthen also the hands of evildoers, that none doth return from his wickedness: they are all of them unto me as Sodom, and the inhabitants thereof as Gomorrah (Jer 23:14 KJV)
- * Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Harken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you: they make you vain: they speak a vision of their own heart, *and* not out of the mouth of the LORD. (Jer 23:16 KJV)
- * They say still unto them that despise me, The LORD hath said, Ye shall have peace; and they say unto every one that walketh after the imagination of his own heart, No evil shall come upon you. (Jer 23:17 KJV)
- * Behold, a whirlwind of the LORD is gone forth in fury, even a grievous whirlwind: it shall fall grievously upon the head of the wicked. (Jer 23:19 KJV)
- * The anger of the LORD shall not return, until he have executed, and till he have performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly. (Jer 23:20 KJV)
- * I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran: I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied. (Jer 23:21 KJV)
- * But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings. (Jer 23:22 KJV)
- * Hear, O earth: behold, I will bring evil upon this people, *even* the fruit of their thoughts, because they have not hearkened unto my words, nor to my law, but rejected it. (Jer 6:19 KJV)

- * ... Thus saith the Lord GOD; Are ye polluted after the manner of your fathers? and commit ye whoredom after their abominations? (Eze 20:30 KJV)
- * I have seen your adulteries And your *lustful* neighings, The lewdness of your harlotry, Your abominations on the hills in the fields. Woe to you, O Jerusalem! Will you still not be made clean?" (Jer 13:27 NKJ)
- * Christ ... loved the church, and gave himself for it; (Eph 5:25 KJV)
- * That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, (Eph 5:26 KJV)
- * Hear the word of the LORD, ye rulers of Sodom; give ear unto the law of our God, ye people of Gomorrah. (Isa 1:10 KJV)
- * "Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean; Put away the evil of your doings from before My eyes. Cease to do evil, (Isa 1:16 NKJ)
- * Learn to do good; Seek justice, Rebuke the oppressor¹; Defend the fatherless, Plead for the widow. (Isa 1:17 NKJ)
- * Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, (Jam 1:27 KJV)
- * ... *and* to keep oneself unspotted from the world. (Jam 1:27 NKJ)
- * Howbeit they did not hearken, but they did after their former manner. (2Ki 17:40 KJV)
- * For they went and served other gods, and worshipped them, ... (Deu 29:26 KJV)
- * ... the gods of the people that *were* round about them (Jdg 2:12 KJV)
- * ... for the spirit of whoredoms hath caused *them* to err, and **they have gone a whoring from under their God.** (Hos 4:12 KJV)
- * Plead with your mother, plead: for she *is* not my wife, neither *am* I her husband: let her therefore put away her whoredoms out of her sight, and her adulteries from between her breasts; (Hos 2:2 KJV)
- * I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not. (Rev 2:21 KJV)
- * ... you allow that woman Jezebel, (Rev 2:20 NKJ)
- * which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols. (Rev 2:20 KJV)
- * ... the doctrine of Balaam (Rev 2:14 KJV)
- * Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds. (Rev 2:22 KJV)
- * Your glorying *is* not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump? (1Co 5:6 KJV)

- * Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make *them* the members of an harlot? God forbid. (1Co 6:15 KJV)
- * ... it *is* confusion. (Lev 18:23 KJV)

- * Flee fornication. ... (1Co 6:18 KJV)
- * ... flee from idolatry. (1Co 10:14 KJV)

- * ... keep yourselves from idols. ... (1Jo 5:21 KJV)
- * ... the gods of the nations ... (2Ch 32:17 KJV)

- * Take heed to thyself that thou be not snared by following them, that thou enquire not after their gods, saying, How did these nations serve their gods? ... (Deu 12:30 KJV)
- * ... I also will do likewise.' (Deu 12:30 NKJ)

- * Thou shalt not do so unto the LORD thy God: for every abomination to the LORD, which he hateth, have they done unto their gods; (Deu 12:31 KJV)

- * What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it. (Deu 12:32 KJV)

- * ... thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: (Mar 12:30 KJV)

- * And ye shall not swear by my name falsely, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I *am* the LORD. (Lev 19:12 KJV)

- * ... I am He who searches the minds and hearts. And I will give to each one of you according to your works. (Rev 2:23 NKJ)

- * ... He that heareth, let him hear; (Eze 3:27 KJV)
